Our summer program also includes a 9-week juvenile justice awareness program for both parents and youth. During this program, both parents and youth will learn how the juvenile justice system & court system work, and understand their legal and educational rights. We will conclude our summer programs with our Sixth Annual Juvenile Justice Panel where we invite local police, juvenile judges, correctional officers, social workers, and other experts to answer questions from parents and youth and interact with each other. Our Summer Program also includes "Girls on the Run" or track for our young girls. Our track program was created to empower young girls to participate in sports while respecting their culture.

The following are activities and programs we offer throughout summer:

- 9 Weeks of Juvenile Justice Awareness Program: Thursdays for Youth, Saturdays for Parents.
- Summer Enrichment Program: Literacy, art, social and cultural components: 8:00 AM to 12:30 PM
 Starting June 25th, 2018
- Educational Field Trips: Total of two field trips throughout the summer.
- Summer Soccer league: June 25th August 24th, 2018
- Girls on the Run starts June 25th, 2018
- 7th Annual Juvenile Justice Panel: Date & place will be announced in late June
